

International Euphonium Institute Behavior Guidelines

The following guidelines provide an outline for the behavior of all participants at the IEI. The participants are expected to demonstrate good judgment and respect the staff, faculty, other participants, and facilities at all times. This information seeks to clarify. Please note that the Student includes students that are currently in high school and those that have just recently graduated regardless of age.

Behavior Guidelines (discipline is stated in parenthesis)

- 1) No use of controlled substances at any event. (Dismissal from the IEI)
- 2) No use of alcohol or tobacco by underage participants. (Dismissal from the IEI)
- 3) Participants in the high school division must attend all events or inform the staff why they were not in attendance.
- 4) Participants in the Student Division (high school) have a 10 PM dorm curfew that will be strictly enforced. (Dismissal from the IEI)
- 5) Participants in the Student Division are expected to Stay On-Campus during the week unless staying with a family member as a Commuter.
- 6) Participants in the Student Division may bring cars to campus, but are not allowed to use, except in the case of an emergency, them during the course of the week. (Dismissal from the IEI)
- 7) Respect the performances and instruments of all other participants and their interest in learning.
- 8) Males may not be present on the female floors of the dorms and females may not be present on the male dorm floors (except for exiting the building).

All discipline decisions will be made by the Camp Director, Adam Frey. His options may include:

- 1) Verbal Warning
- 2) Dismissal from a Master Class or Rehearsal
- 3) Parent or Guardian Phone Conference (if applicable)
- 4) Dismissal from the IEI without refund of fees. Participant will be asked to leave campus. If applicable, Parent or Guardian must arrange for transportation from the IEI at their own expense in no more than 24 hours from the occurrence of the incident.

The resulting discipline will be determined based on the severity of the infraction.
